### *Calls for Service*

The New Lenox Police Department handled 2,177 calls for service for the month of September. A call for service, simply put, is any sort of activity police personnel perform which is logged through Lincoln-Way Public Safety Communication Center (dispatch). Incidents in this category are representative of events either dispatched or officer initiated. Calls for service include criminal, non-criminal and administrative activity.
