

ORDINANCE NO. 2608

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 78 OF THE
MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LENOX, ILLINOIS
(Timing for Payment of Water and Sanitary Sewer Tap-On Fees)

WHEREAS, the New Lenox Village Board of Trustees has deemed it to be in the best interest of the Village of New Lenox, Illinois, to amend certain portions of Chapter 78 as they pertain to the payment of water and sanitary sewer connection charges; and,

WHEREAS, the New Lenox Village Board of Trustees has determined that collecting water and sanitary sewer connection charges for new residential subdivisions at the time of issuance of a building permit for each new residential unit, at the rate then in effect, is in the best interest of Village residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of New Lenox, Will County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That Section 78-144 shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

Sec. 78-144. - Contribution for connection to public water or sewer system.

(a) At the time of issuance of a building permit for each new building in a subdivision connecting to the existing water mains of the village, the permit applicant shall pay to the village the applicable connection charge set forth in section 94-271.

(b) At the time of issuance of a building permit for each new building in a subdivision connecting to the existing sewer mains of the village, the permit applicant shall pay to the village the applicable connection charge set forth in section 94-143.

Section 2: Severability: That each section and part hereof of this ordinance is deemed to be severable and should any section or part hereof be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such ruling shall not affect the validity of constitutionality of the remaining portion(s) of this ordinance.

Section 3: Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances: That all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed and of no further force and effect to the extent of any such conflict.

Section 4: Publication: That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this ordinance in pamphlet form.

Section 5: Effective Date: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
