CRIME REPORTING

The criteria used for UCR reporting is more restrictive and would not reflect the broad range of activity to which our personnel respond.

PATROL

Calls for Service

The New Lenox Police Department handled 3,429 calls for service for the month of March. A call for service, simply put, is any sort of activity police personnel perform which is logged through Lincoln-Way Public Safety Communication Center (dispatch). Incidents in this category are representative of events either dispatched or officer initiated. Calls for service include criminal, non-criminal and administrative activity.

Cases of Interest

Commercial Burglary:

On March 13th a Burglary occurred at the Village Liquor Mart on North Cedar Road. Forced entry was made through a rear door and a case of beer was stolen. Three male individuals were observed on store security cameras. Further investigation of the incident led to the arrest of three offenders:

Ryan Dominski, David Feehery, and Hank Oram. They were each subsequently charged with Burglary.

Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse:

A Suspicious Incident Investigation led to the arrest of 20 year old Dustin Radatz. Radatz was charged with Aggravated Criminal Sexual Assault after it was learned that he had sex with a minor.
