About This Report

Glossary

Part One Crimes – Eight crimes, determined by the State of Illinois and the Federal Bureau of Investigations, are used for conformity in crime reporting. These eight crimes were determined based on seriousness and frequency of the crime. The eight crimes are: murder, criminal sexual assault, robbery, aggravated battery/assault, burglary, theft, motor vehicle theft and arson.

Part Two Crimes – All other reportable crimes, excluding the eight Part One crimes.

Calls For Service – Any request for police assistance or service provided by a New Lenox Police Officer.

Assigned Case – Any incident report that requires follow-up investigation by an officer or detective.

Parking & Compliance Violation – A violation of a municipal regulation governing the condition or use of equipment on a vehicle or governing the display of a municipal vehicle tax license.

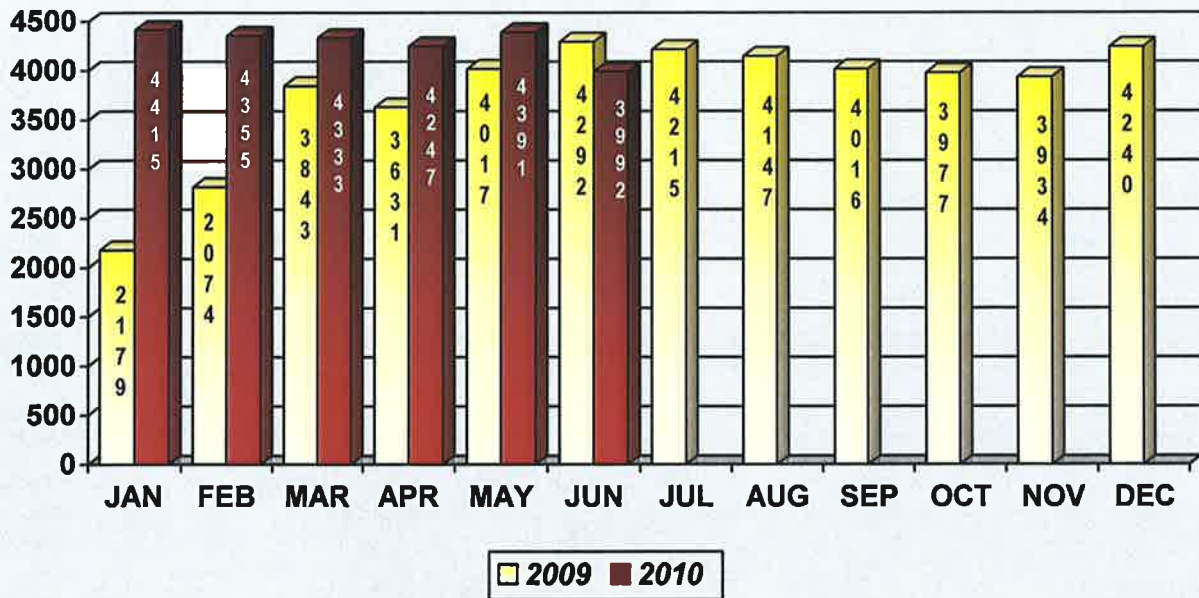
Local Ordinance Violation – An administrative ticket used in the case of certain minor Village of New Lenox ordinance violations in lieu of arrest.

Premise Check – A self-initiated activity conducted by a patrol officer. Premise checks include banks, schools and businesses.

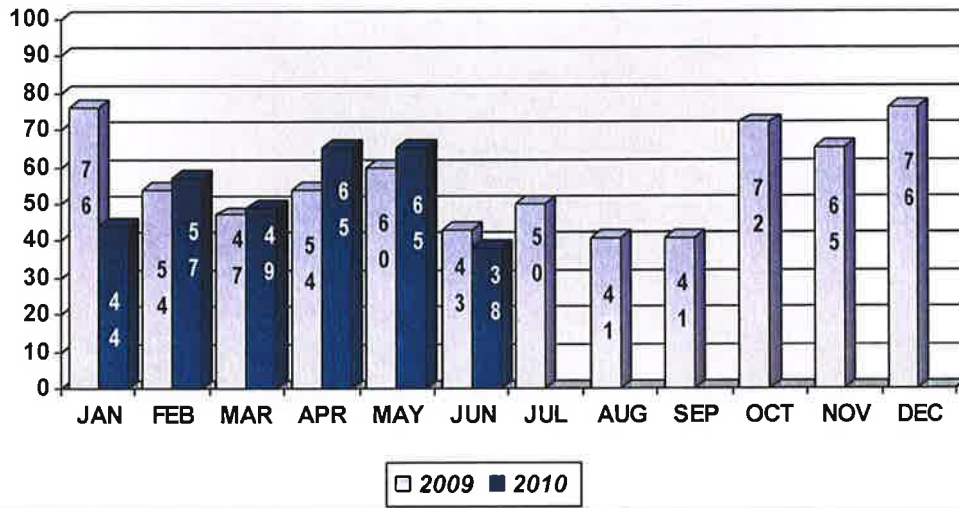

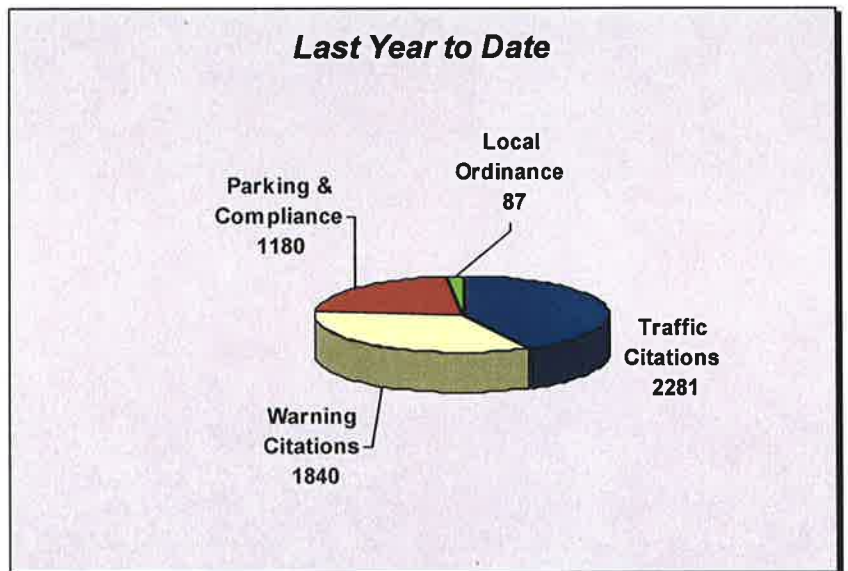

Top Crash Locations

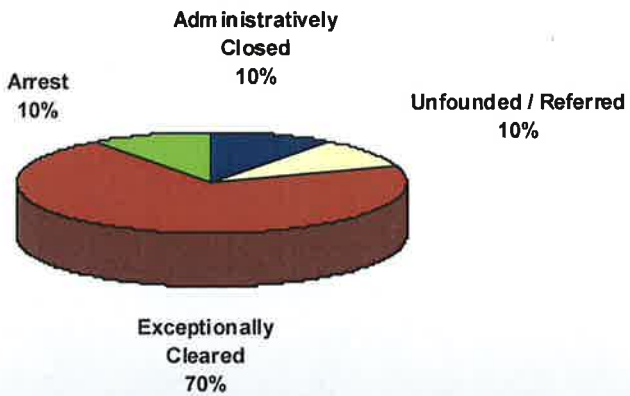

Referred to another agency

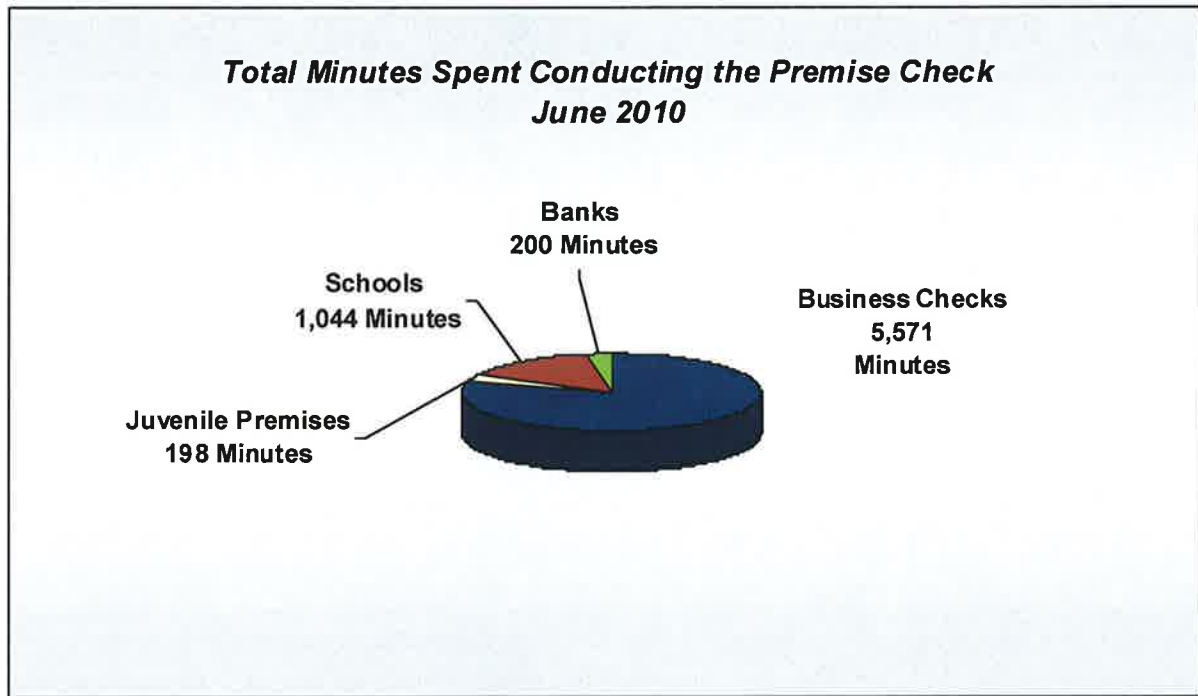
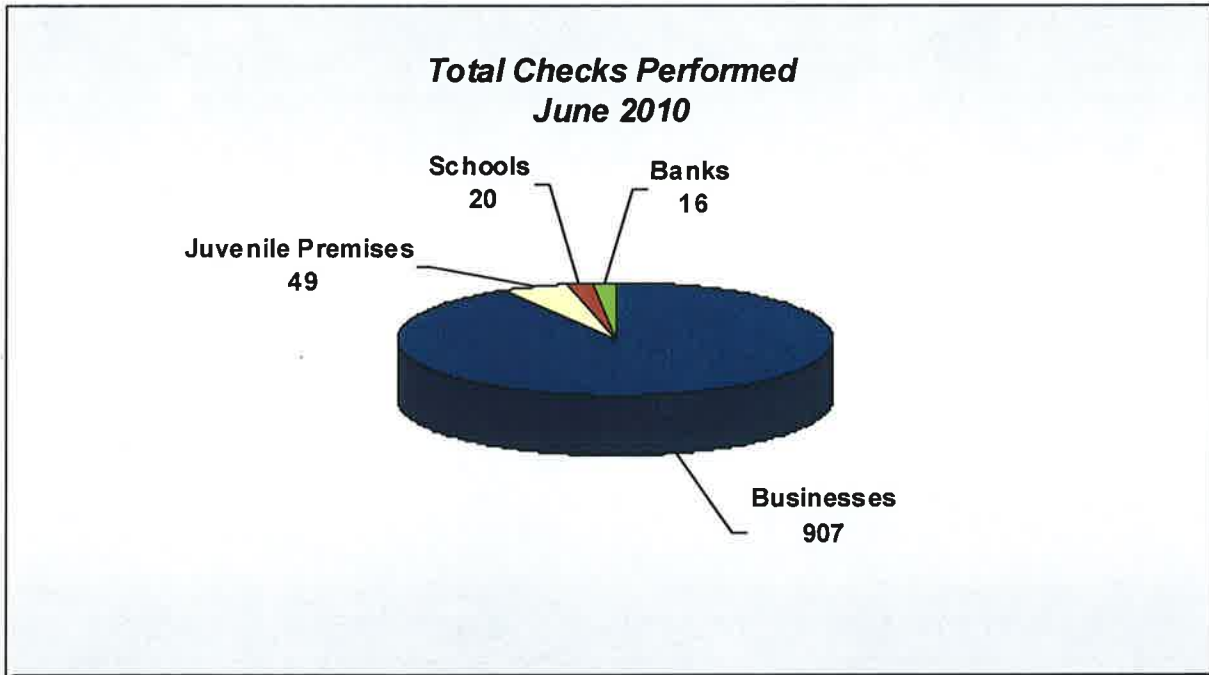
Adult & Juvenile Arrest
